	Points Earned	Student attempts to match photocopy values in a drawing using graphite	Student uses the crosshatching technique to control value	Student demonstrates skill and technical refinement
Student shows strong understanding and exhibits it with exceptional creativity	5	Value matches seamlessly with the photocopy	Crosshatching is smooth, consistent, and effective without crushing the paper fibers	Work is free from damage with an obvious effort to protect the condition of the work And All project steps are followed correctly
Student shows strong understanding and completes objective with outstanding success	4	Value matches that in the photocopy in at least 3 specific areas	Crosshatching is consistently used but appears uneven or slightly course	Great care is apparent in the finished work but slight damage or smudging the graphite detracts from the work
Student successfully demonstrates an understanding of the objective	3	Value change is related to that in the photocopy	Crosshatching is consistently used but appears rough, uneven, smudged, or crushes the paper fiber	Work is in fair condition and the project is executed correctly
Student attempts but fails to exhibit an understanding of a given objective	2	A variety of values exist in the drawing but are unrelated to the value in the photocopy	Crosshatching is inconsistent, and control over the technique is lacking	Lack of proper care for the work is apparent or work appears unfinished
Student completes assignment but exhibits poor understanding and effort	1	Less than 3 values are used in the drawing.	Crosshatching is either un used or appears accidental	A clear and obvious lack of proper care and respect for the work is obvious
