Week 3

Step 1

Create a work of art in the artist's style. On a separate sheet of paper create a hand made duplicate of one of your artist's works. If you artist is a painter then you must use paint to create a work of art like that of your artist. If, however, your artist used media (art materials) you are unfamiliar with, you should chose your media as close to that of your artist as you can get. If you have questions about which media to use, ask your teacher. The artwork must be at least 8.5" X 11" in size.

Step 2

Using your worksheets from weeks 1 and 2, write a research report on an artist. The report must be in essay format and it should be at least a page and a half long, typed, and double spaced. If you do not have access to a word processor, your report may be hand-written. Make sure it is written neatly as points will be deducted for papers that are difficult to read. If hand-written, the report should be at least two and a half pages long.

Your essay research should include the following information:

Note: use a separate piece of paper for the above information written in a report.
